PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS

- I. In conformity with K.S.A.72-2241, the Board of Education authorizes payroll deductions for the following purposes:
 - A. Accident Insurance
 - **B.** Cancer Insurance
 - C. Certified Staff Union Dues
 - D. Dependent Life Insurance
 - E. Education Savings Plans
 - F. Group Medical and Dental Insurance
 - **G.** Group Prescription Drug Insurance
 - H. Identity Theft Insurance
 - I. Long-Term Care Insurance
 - J. Horace Mann Retirement
 - K. Horace Mann Retirement
 - L. Medical Flexible Spending Accouts
 - M. Optional Life Insurance
 - N. Short-Term Disability Insurance
 - O. Supplemental Medical Insurance
 - P. Topeka Public Schools Foundation
 - Q. United Way Contributions
 - R. Vision Insurance
 - S. Well Child Care Flexible Spending Accounts

Payroll deductions for any of the purposes set forth herein shall be made only after the employee has signed a proper authorization form setting forth the amount, the purpose, and the disposition of the amount to be deducted.

- II. In conformity with K.S.A. 60-732(2), and K.S.A. 23-3104, the Board of Education authorizes payroll deductions of administrative fees, up to the maximum allowed by law, for the following purposes:
 - A. Garnishments
 - B. Withholding Orders
 - C. Tax Levies

The payroll deduction of administration fees shall be made only after the district has received a directive from: a Kansas or Federal Court, the Kansas Department of Revenue, the Internal Revenue Service, or national student loan collection agencies to make payroll deductions from a district employee's paycheck.

The amount of the administration fee should be sufficient to cover all costs of complying with the directive of the Court, or state and federal agencies.
