Campus Care Clinic

A Board-Certified Family Practice Nurse Practitioner will diagnose, treat and prescribe medications (if necessary), and may refer to healthcare providers in the surrounding community.

Campus Care Clinic will see students and staff for the following conditions (Please note this list is not comprehensive):

Wellness

- Annual Physicals, Well Adolescent Exams, Sports Physicals
- TB testing
- Weight Management
- Immunizations (Meningitis, HPV, Flu)
- Screening: glucose, urine, blood pressure, cholesterol
- STD testing (urine sample)

Acute Illness and Injury

- Rapid strep, flu and mono testing
- Urinalysis
- Suture placement and removal
- Asthma exacerbation
- Pain and injury (examples- sprained ankle, knee or elbow pain; abdominal pain; headaches)
- Acute stress reactions

Chronic Illness

- Mental Health screening and referral
- Substance use screening and counseling
- High blood pressure screening and management
- Diabetes screening and management
- Asthma management
- Thyroid condition screening and management
- Depression and Anxiety
- Stress management
- ADHD management (referral for initial diagnosis)
