The following are available services the clinic provides. Please note this list is not comprehensive.

Wellness

- Annual physical exam
- Well-child/adolescent exam
- Sports physical
- TB testing
- Weight management
- Immunizations (HPV, flu, meningitis, Tdap, etc.)
- Blood pressure screening
- Lab work (complete blood count, glucose, kidney/liver/thyroid function)
- STD testing (urine sample)

Acute illness

- Rapid strep testing
- Flu testing
- Mono testing
- COVID-19 testing (rapid or PCR)
- Urinary tract infection
- Upper respiratory infection
- Sinus infection
- Suture placement and removal
- Pain and injury (such as headache, abdominal pain, sprained ankle or knee, elbow pain)
- Acute stress reactions

Chronic illness

- Diabetes
- High blood pressure
- High cholesterol
- Asthma
- Thyroid conditions
- Mental health screening
- Depression
- Anxiety
- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD – requires referral for initial diagnosis)
- Substance use
